I am Wael Sous from Egypt, with family Odette Hanna, Joy Sous (21) and Moheb Sous (18).

In 1997, I graduated from the Evangelical Theological Seminary in Cairo, Egypt, with a Masters of Divinity. I pastored churches in Egypt for nearly 20 years.

In 2013, we began to be persecuted and threatened by the Muslim Brotherhood. For our family's safety we decided to visit friends in Bryan, TX, arriving June 13, 2013. We lived in Texas approximately 3 years and then went to Wichita, KS, for about 8 months to help with refugees there.

The call to our ministry has always been on our minds. We heard about the Arabic speaking community in Nashville, TN, and sensed a call to an Arabic church in Antioch, TN, where we served nine months. Following that we began a new church plant on July 1, 2016.

About 3 months ago, God pressed on Odette and me a larger vision to reach more Arabic people. There are approximately 30,000 to 40,000 Arabic people living in Nashville, maybe more. These Arabic people are mainly from Egypt, Jordan, Iraq and Syria.

The Vision:

- To point these people to Jesus while loving them with His love.
- To see them become members of God's family through evangelism.
- To disciple them and develop in them Christ-like maturity; equipping them to serve Him for His glory.
- To build relationships with the Arabic people.
- To establish home Bible study groups.
- To develop leadership training. (Team work).
- To train others to make disciples.
- To pray for more ministers in the Smyrna-Mt. Juliet-Nashville area.

This is our vision. We are praying daily for it and we hope you will be willing to share with us in our vision, both in prayer and in financial support. Currently, we have immediate financial challenges and need help.

We are trying to raise our monthly support until I can be supported full time in my ministry. I am establishing home bible study groups to share God's word.

My ministry is for the Glory of God and to Glorify His name.
